Over the past month, Miss Chen a woman in our nursing home ministry accepted the Lord. She told us she has no family, we told her we are your family. Another conversion happened in a hospital. Mr. Yen who is now going through chemo therapy, accepted the Lord. Pray for these new believers that they will be serious about their commitment and would wanted to be baptized. A couple has rededicated their life to the Lord. Mr. Hsu and his wife live in our community. Mr. Hsu attends a



cell group in a nearby church on Friday morning. Mrs. Hsu is going through discipleship training with Lily. They are attending our Sunday morning worship. We are going to disciple them although Mr. Hsu is uneducated and only understands Taiwanese. Pray for us as we work with this couple.



In our last prayer letter, we told you about a cross cultural servant named Sandy. She has asked for prayer for herself and the team that is going with her to Papua New Guinea for three months. They will do some training and visiting in remote villages. Pray for spiritual wisdom as they face a strong voodoo culture. Also, Sandy is trying to come under a mission organization but it taking a long time for this to happen. Pray that she will not get discouraged.

As we come into June, we will be wrapping up our campus ministry. We know many kids like the story time at the elementary school. Tim's story time name is Harry. Some kids will yell from the playground "Hi, HARRY!" when they see him. We are thankful for the seeds planted this semester. We don't have a sure number who will go to our camps, maybe the number will be lower than we had hoped. Pray as we move into summer ministry where there are many opportunities for children and youth ministry.



Thank you for praying for us as we had to get a new motorcycle for ministry. We were thankful to find a good deal and get a rebate from the government for getting rid of our old motorcycle. As always, please pray for our safety on the motorcycle.

We were thankful for a wonderful Mother's day service. There were many who brought their mothers or mother-in-laws. The men did the cooking for the lunch after service. We had a wonderful time.



Because of the very warm weather, Tim is spending his afternoons in the church office, so he can get up and walk around as his doctor recommends. This would not be possible in the library for him. We are thankful this can work out.

We only have three Sunday's left open for our time of partnership building in the US. The dates are Sept. 18, Sept. 25, and Oct. 2. We have tried to contact a few of you, but the phone numbers did not work. Please if you want us, contact us ASAP. Also pray for our housing situation when we are in the US. We will be in the North Canton area from Aug. 15 to Oct. 23.
