It was almost like being in the ark. In the second week of July, we were invited to help a small church. We are thankful for some of our youth who could help out with Joycelyn.



This week is the children's camp. There are seven children and two adults going to camp. Joycelyn sent a text saying the kids got to know each other very quickly that it is getting louder. Pray for all the teachings and the kids to really know Jesus.



A special thanks to Ian, Vincent, and Jim for helping a couple in the church to clean their house. The woman, Mrs. Syu injured her leg in a fall. She has some difficulty moving around. We arranged for these three youth to go and help clean one morning. Her husband is a new believer. Still needs to grow in truly living for Jesus, but he is uneducated.

Our Evergreen Fellowship group went to a home to celebrate a birthday for a man who is not a believer yet. It was a time to encourage him and his daughter named Lynn. The man's name is Mr. Chen and his wife has dementia and it has been a challenge for the family and our church. Please pray for Mr. Chen's heart to be release from his own way of thinking.

Pray for Joycelyn and Josephine who will take on a lot of our ministry while we are in the US. As you know we have several new believers that Lily has been following up and we want them to continue to grow. Pray mature believers to surround them in love.
