We were glad we could help out. A couple of fun things we did was Lily went to her first high school football game. Lily enjoyed the band. We also got to go to an Indians baseball game. In our presentation we shared about how we travel around our city. If you remember we gave a demonstration about our scooter. In one of the pictures is Tim on the motorcycle with his friend Mark. Another special trip was a day trip to Wilmore. We visited the Wilmore Free Methodist Church and The Asbury Theological Seminary campus. We had a special visit with Dr. Donald Joy and his wife.
