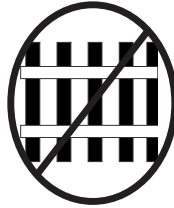
Did you know?

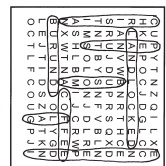
