People who live in the Democratic Republic of Congo, or DRC, are called Congolese.

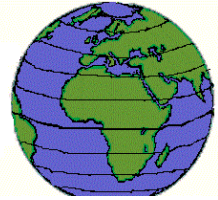
The okapi is DRC's national animal. It is a member of the giraffe family and eats leaves and fruit.
