The capital, Conakry, is also the largest city.

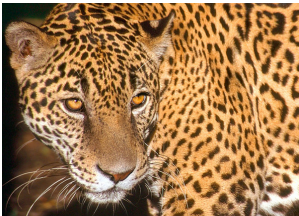


Guinea-Conakry is a small country with a variety of landscapes including tropical dry forests, rainforests and beautiful waterfalls.
