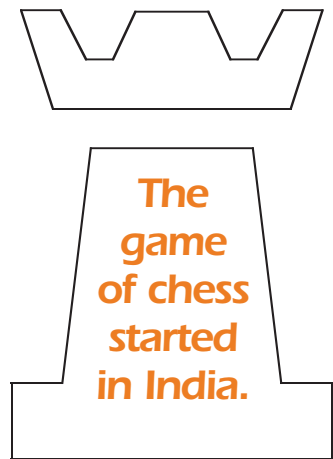


The wheel in the center of India's flag represents the laws.
