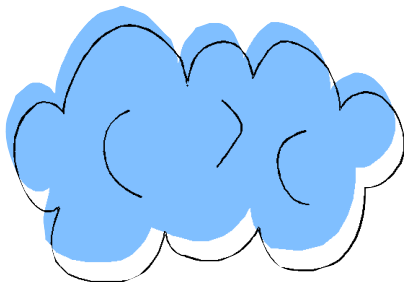
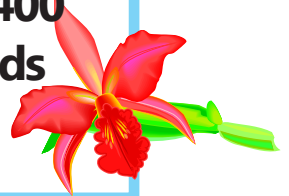

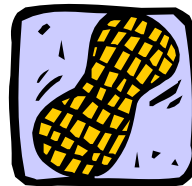
Did you know?

grown in Malawi.



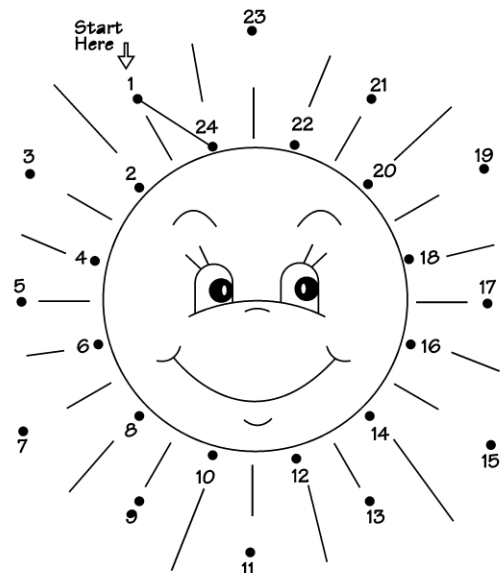
Peanuts and tea are
