Bonobos, a type of ape, are found in Republic of Congo Brazzaville.



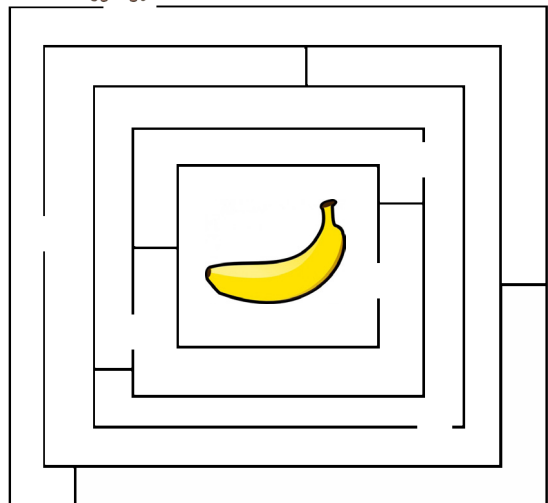
The giant otter shrew is a mammal that has a long flat tail used for swimming. Its muzzle is covered with bristles and has flat shielded nostrils.



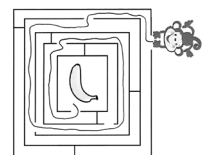
