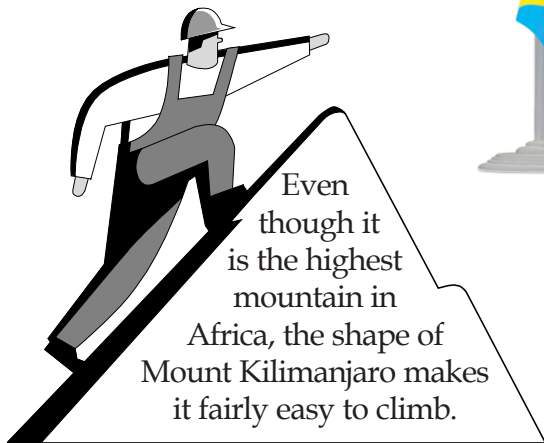

The former capital of Tanzania is Dar es Salaam. The name means "haven of peace."

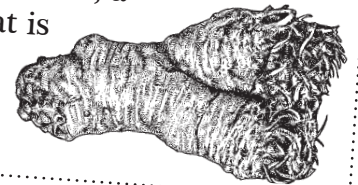


Even though it is the highest mountain in Africa, the shape of Mount Kilimanjaro makes it fairly easy to climb.
