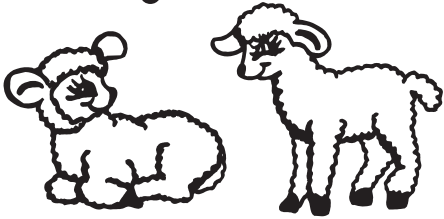

You can find kangaroos, koalas, camels, wombats and duck-billed platypus in Australia.



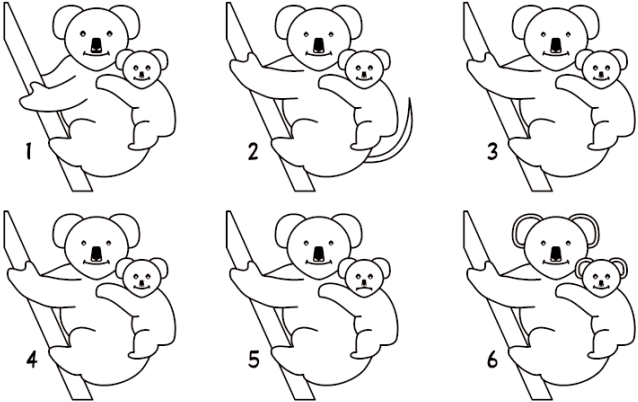
The country of Australia is almost as large as the United States.
