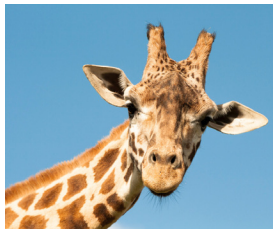
Did you know?

The lightning bird, or Zimbabwe bird, is the national symbol and is pictured on the flag & currency.



A zorilla looks like a weasel but gives off a skunk-like smell to scare off predators.

You'll find fruit here such as guavas, mangoes (pictured above), lady finger bananas and papayas (pictured left).



Many parks and wildlife sanctuaries protect the animals.

There are more than 300 species of mammals in Zimbabwe.

Victoria Falls are water falls bigger than North America's Niagara Falls. The noise of the falls can be heard 10 miles away, and the mist can be seen 4 miles away.
