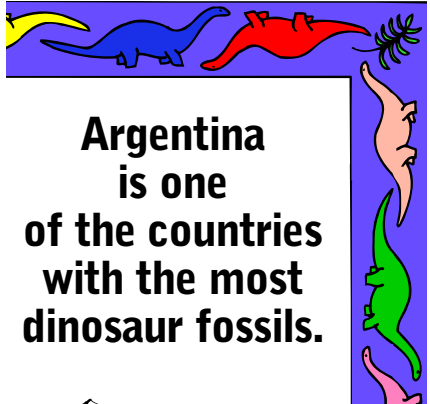

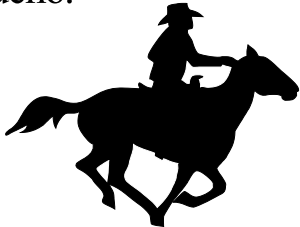
Capital city: Buenos Aires

At the end of June, the people of Argentina celebrate a Day of Friendship. They send cards and call their friends.



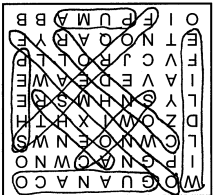
