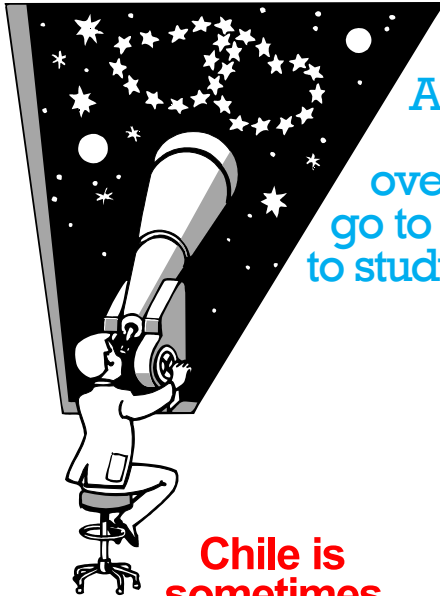

Astronomers from all over the world go to Chile to study the stars.

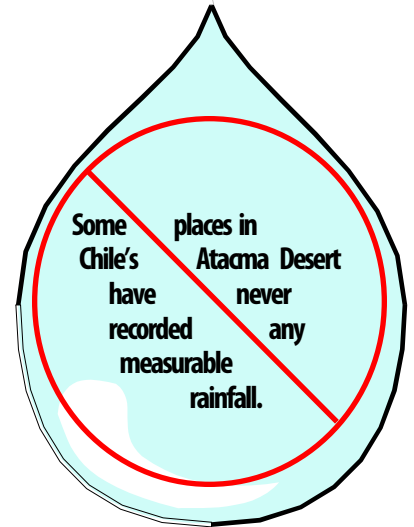


Chile is sometimes called the "Shoestring Nation" because of its long, thin shape.
