As we prepare to go home to Quincy to celebrate our Savior's birth and spend time with our family, the need to say 'Thank you' presses on our minds. Without your help and prayers we would not be able to be here in Haiti. There are many challenges that mark each day here, from trying to sleep with the dogs, roosters and drums going all night, to trying to traverse the Haiti roads. Dealing with the abundance of un-road worthy vehicles, motorcycles, goats, dogs & pigs can be challenging. Prayer is a necessity before each trip out. These are just a few of the normal 'stresses' we deal with. When and if you come to Haiti, you will go home with a new list of 'Haiti Happenings' too!

Some of the upcoming projects that are in the works which we will be a part of are:

- Double the electrical service at the Dessalines hospital.
- Relocate the hospital back-up generators to provide better security and better maintenance access.
- Finish repairing and install a back-up generator for HPU's (Haiti Providence University) water system.
- Continue to help with construction and farming at the University's campus.
- Help develop the new property for FOHO (Friends of Haiti Organization), i.e. wall, new shop, caretakers housing, new well and water system.
- Continue to purchase supplies and building materials for incoming teams.

- Repair equipment & tools.
- Try to train Haitian staff to do all of the above. ☺

These are only a few of the things on the list to be done in the months ahead. We ask for your prayerful support to give us the endurance to live in Haiti and enable us to be successful in the work the Lord has laid out for us for the upcoming season. We also ask for your financial support which allows us to be in Haiti to do this work. Without the Lord's awesome plan for our lives and your continued support, we will be unable to accomplish this. We are exceedingly grateful for both. Not only does your support go to help us with our daily expenses, it helps many students go to school. So far this year we have been able to help over eight families consisting of 19 children, two of which are receiving University level education. We personally know these families and without your support these children would not get their education. Saying 'thank you' doesn't suffice but it is all we can say.
