The frailejones (similar to a daisy) grows up to 10-12 feet tall.

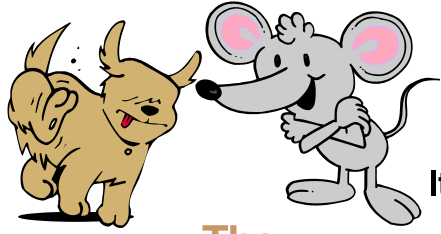


Colombia is the only country named after explorer Christopher Columbus.

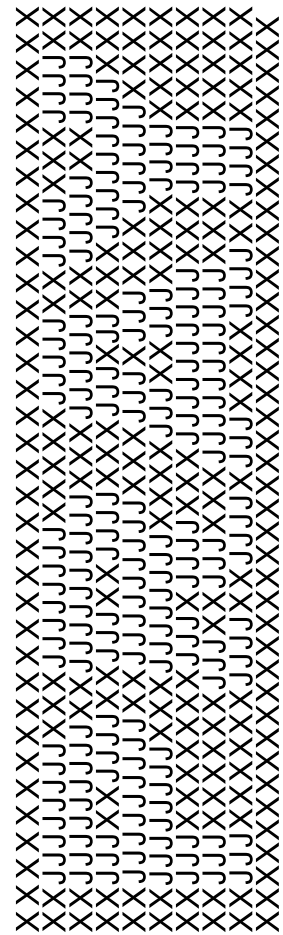


The mountain paca, a rodent as big as a dog, lives in Colombia.
