



Discovering God's Plan for all People

Multi-Ethnic Ministry Series: Video 5 - Dialogue 1

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- Group Facilitator:** Take a moment to outline what the discussion will be, and open your time together with prayer.
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- Scripture Reading:** Exodus 22:21; 23:9
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- Opening Exercise:** View Video 5 – “Embracing All People”
- Give participants a moment of silence after viewing the video to reflect on what phrase or idea left the greatest impression on them. Have participants write down the phrase or idea so they don't forget!
- Ask, “What spoke to you and why?”
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- Opening Questions:** What are some of the reasons immigrants come to the United States?
- Identify examples from the Bible where people migrated to a different land. (e.g. Abraham, Moses, Joseph, Ruth)
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- Scripture Focus:** Acts 17:22-34
- What does this passage tell us about God's active work in the world?
- How inclusive is God's plan for the diverse people groups that exist?
- What is the significance of when and where we live?
- Are there geographical boundaries to what God seeks to do in the world?
- What does bringing all people everywhere to repentance and faith in Jesus require?
- How does the declaration of the gospel work together with the movement of people groups?
- What can you learn from this passage and apply to the diversity of people groups that live in our community? Our city?
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- Personal Response:** Is there someone who is always crossing your path, but who you have not connected with? Do you think God is offering you an opportunity to connect? Names one specific thing you could do to embrace that person.
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- Group Facilitator:** Have participants close their time together with prayer.
