One city in the DR, San Pedro de Macoris, produces more professional baseball players than any other town in the world.

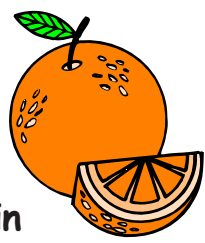

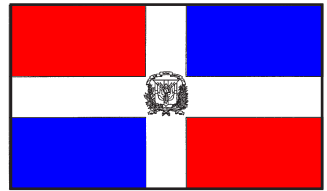


Larimar is a semi-precious stone found ONLY in the DR. The color of blue in the stone varies from deep sky blue to blue green.
