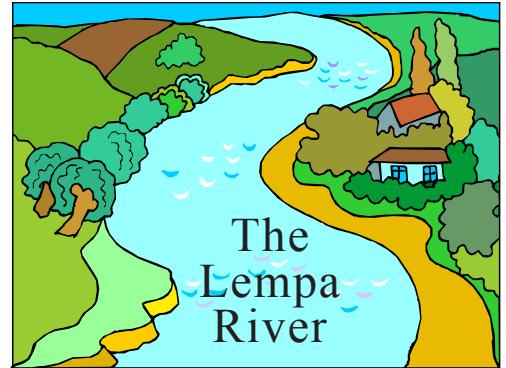
Capital city: San Salvador

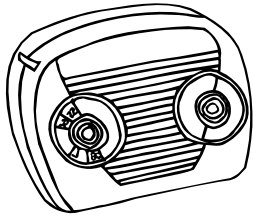
El Salvador means "land of the jewel."
