Kakum National Park has an aerial walk-way: a bridge, 12 stories off the ground, that allows you to walk in a circle among 8 huge trees.

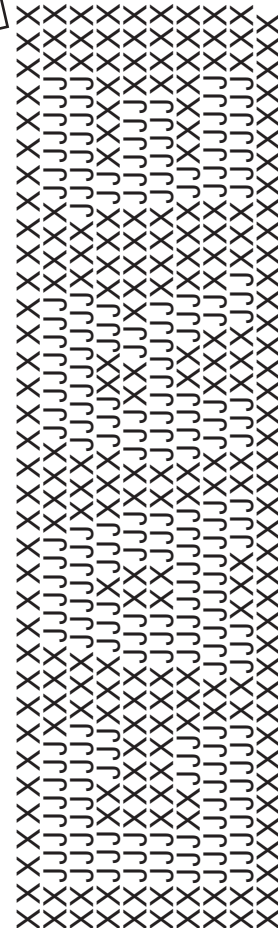
Christian missionaries went to Ghana in the 15th century (in the 1600s) to establish schools.

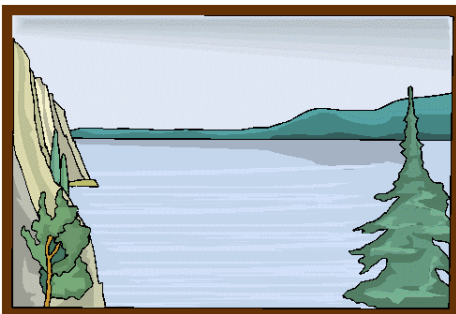
