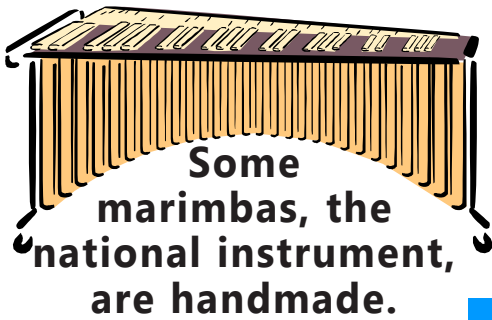
Did you know?
