The rhea is a bird that lives in Paraguay. It looks like an ostrich but can't fly.

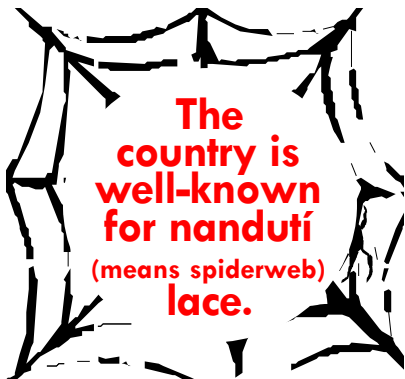


The name Paraguay is said to come from the Indian word meaning "river that gives birth to the sea."

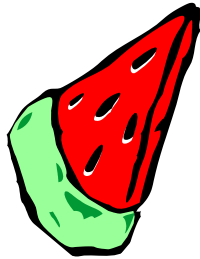
Paraguayans do not mix watermelon in a fruit salad because they believe it causes stomachaches.



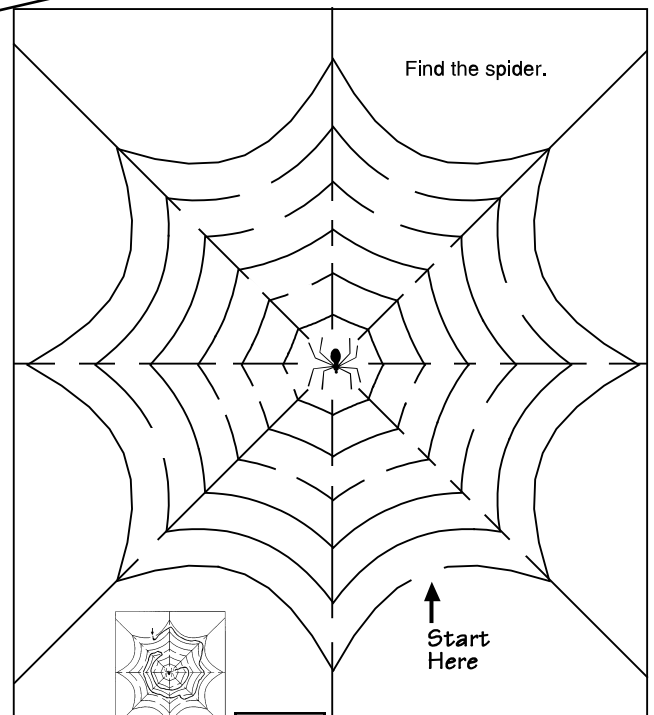
The Itaipú Dam is the largest hydroelectric dam in the world.
