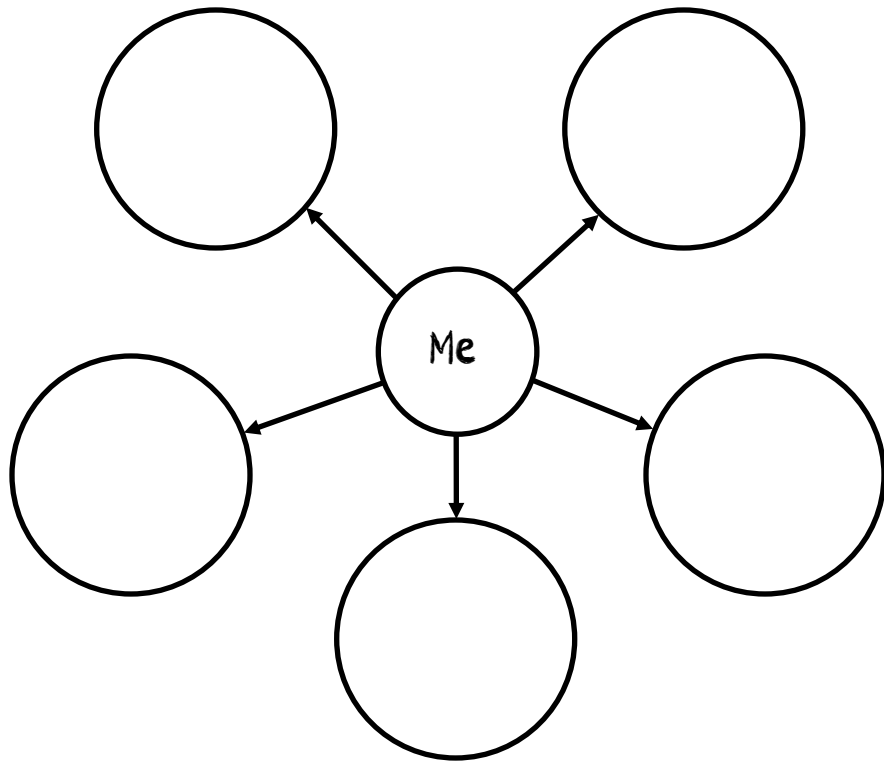
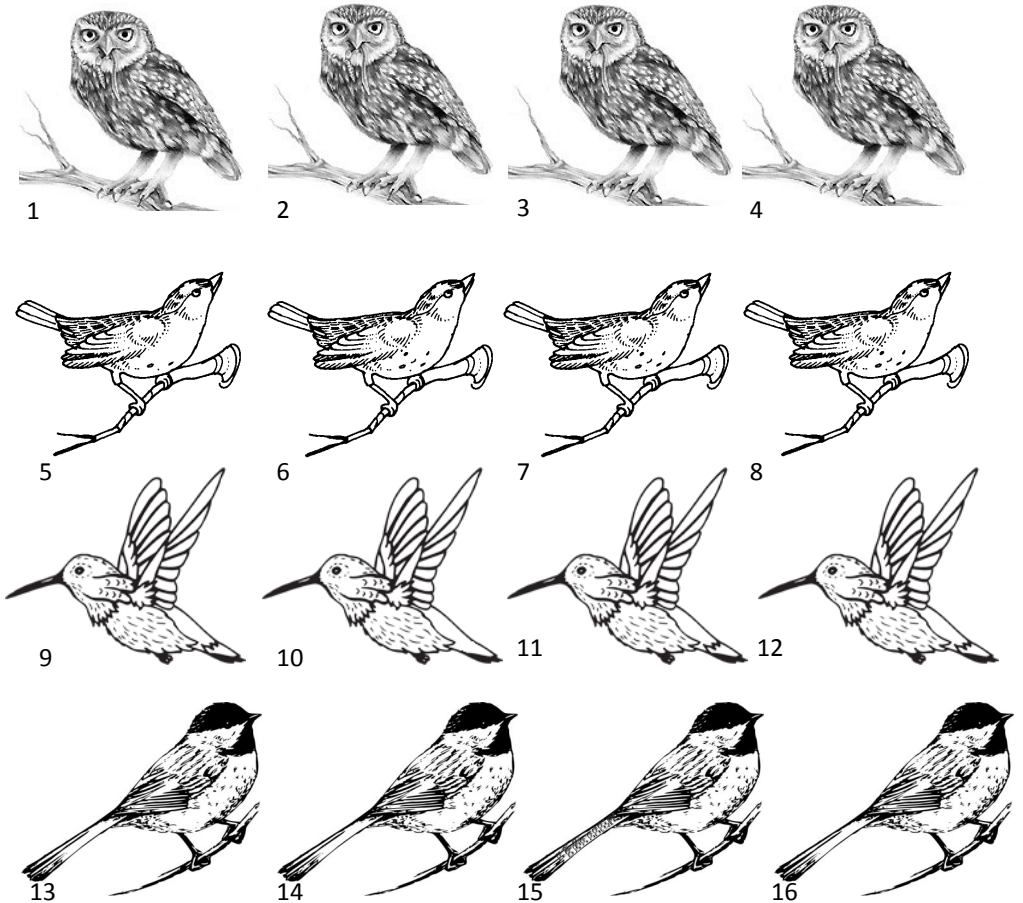


# SCATTERED.
