

Dear prayer partners in our ministry,

Greetings in the name of Jesus. Thank you for being a part of our ministry. It is our joy to share with you what the Lord is doing through your prayer and financial support.

In September, we started a class with five and six year old children. We are blessed to have the ability to offer this kind of class in our church. We meet on Wednesday and Friday afternoons. We are studying about Daniel and his friends using polite words. For example may I, please, and thank you. While we are in the classroom, the mothers also share with each other in the office. The children are eager to learn English. Pray for wisdom as we teach these children. They do not read, so they need to listen to our voice and make the correct sounds. Thank you for praying for them.



Our campus ministry began in mid September. We have elementary class on Wednesday morning and junior high class on Friday morning. The Friday morning class has 26 students. We found out most of them have difficulty learning English. We are thinking to offer a class on Saturday afternoons. Pray for us to be sure this is what the Lord wants us to do.

Thank you for praying for our Wednesday evening Bible application and prayer time. This year, we focus on "God's heart for the family." The next three months we will focus on preparing the church for cell groups. Next year we will be intentional for evangelism and

discipleship. We want to train leaders for this ministry. This will be an all church ministry. Pray for the Holy Spirit to work through the whole church.

We want to share with you about a woman named Sherry. She was a woman in our ministry several years ago. We have stayed in contact with her since she moved to another city to take care of her mother. Recently she took her mother back to her house and asked us to meet them. In the women's fellowship Sherry told us her problem to be baptized is her mother. Her mother told her, "You cannot be baptized until after I pass away." Please prayer for Sherry and her mother to know Jesus more and more.



We have several Indonesian care givers in our ministry. They are all Muslim. We don't speak the Indonesian language. Through a friend, we invited two Christian Indonesian workers to meet them. Mona and Yosi came to our older group fellowship and shared with them. One of them will continue to come to this fellowship once a month. Pray for these care givers' hearts to be touched.

In November we will have our annual out door worship. During the month of October is open for people to register. This is an opportunity to invite our non-Christian family members and friends. Our goal is at least eighty people would join this event.
