Thank you for praying for our Taiwan Father's Day Sunday. Sandy shared from the story of the prodigal son. Her theme was "Enjoy the Father's Love". One man, he just got out of prison came to the church on that day. He felt the story was just like him. Pray for Mr. Lu to not go back to his old ways. His mother is very concerned because she does not see any change in him. We shared the gospel with him. But he did not make a decision. In the Father's Day picture, Mr. Lu is the third from the left.

Thank you for praying for our youth group overnight retreat. This time helped us understand the difficulties these young people have. For example, reading Bible, some of the boys use bad language, and cooperating with each other. We found two people, Ben and Amy, can be disciplined. We combined with another church youth group to help them know each other. Pray for Julia who wants to be a leader but needs to become more mature. Pray for Joycelyn who needs wisdom to pastor this group.

Praise the Lord! Recently two people accepted the Lord. Ashley, a 30 year old woman was invited to church by her mother. We keep in contact with her in the hope we can disciple her. We invited Ashley to come to our English fellowship. Another woman, Mrs. Huang, is the grandmother of Lydia who helps with the church Sunday School, accepted the Lord on Tuesday Aug. 28th in her house. Mrs. Huang broke her legs two months ago and still is in wheel chair. She is doing physical therapy twice a week. We promised to pray for her, so will pray with us for her complete and quick healing so she can come to the church. We have started the discipleship with her. Please pray for Ashley and Mrs. Huang to have desire to grow in their faith.

Continue to pray for our Indonesian care givers. In the Evergreen fellowship, Yosi, a missionary from Indonesia, always shares a message from the Bible to the care givers. Through Q & A, we can see some openness in their hearts. Pray for the Holy Spirit to touch their minds and hearts. Our next meeting will be Sep. 18th.

We enjoyed a three day trip to an offshore island called Kinmen. This was a retreat for all the Taiwan Free Methodist pastors and their spouses. Lily and Joycelyn shared their faith with Mr. Wang in his post office. We know he was baptized when he was young but doesn't

have church life. The high light for Tim is visiting the historical places in Kinmen. Please pray for Mr. Wang to read the tract that Lily gave him and find a way back to the church.

Box drum class will have two classes, one for new learners, and one for old students. The purpose of these classes is for outreach to our community. Pray for more people to register for these classes.
