OUR GREATEST JOYS IN JANUARY

Ellas Women's Ministry: The ministry of women has seen wonderful multiplication as the ladies are motivated to reach others for Christ. Our meetings are held three times a year with praise, prayer, sharing, preaching and fellowship.

Social Ministry / Barnabas Project: Our local outreach ministry has grown, and we continue to bring food and the gospel message to the homeless and even those who have a home, but come to eat with us in downtown Lisbon because they have no food at home. Other families receive a basket of food once a month. The Barnabas Project has helped those in need with clothes, shoes, furniture and medicine.

In São Tomé and Príncipe / Africa: Our mission there has already born fruit. The Souza Family is excited by what God has already done. Now they have a larger room with electricity, and the social ministry is in full operation. Future leaders are being trained and families are receiving both food and pastoral help. Moses and Jacione are teaching classes to those who are preparing for baptism.

SPECIAL GUESTS IN APRIL

A group from the Wilmore, Ky FMC, led by Jerry Coleman spent 10 days here and helped with training, preaching, the food bank, and a prayer walk through Fatima, one of the most important Catholic shrines in the world. Visiting retired Pastor David and his wife Charlotte Dyer from Canada calls for more support for this ministry especially for a new facility for the church in Lisbon as they have 'crowded out' the space they are currently renting. Dr. Howard Snyder and his wife Janice also came to help with the training for our seminary students.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Angelos will attend a **conference in Egypt** from May 13 - 17, along with a group of pastors from the Evangelical Alliance of Portugal.

A **Discipleship Conference** is scheduled for the end of May, where all churches will be encouraged to develop a vision for growth through discipleship and the multiplication of cells and congregations.

Several people are getting ready to spend 8 days helping the FMC in **Guinea Bissau** as the Angelos started the vision there nearly 20 years ago. This group plans to inaugurate a school and train the leadership there besides encouraging Pastor Rito and his family.

We look forward to the **baptism and reception of new members** in the coming months of June and July.
