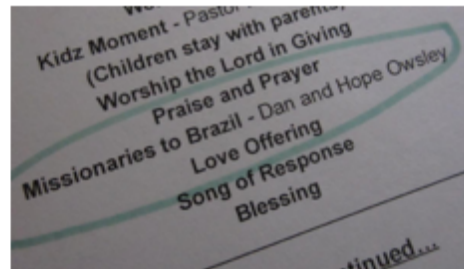
Dear Praying Friends,
