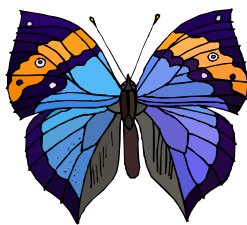
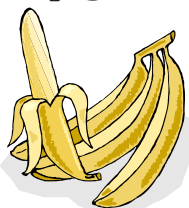
## Did you know?

Bananas are the country's most valuable crop. They did not originally grow in Honduras but were brought from Africa.

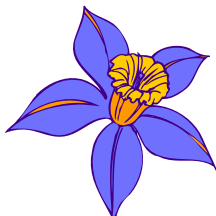


The Butterfly and Insect Museum in La Ceiba is
