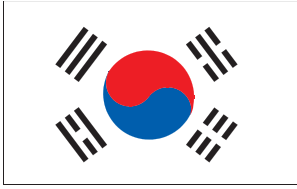


# South Korea

## Did you know?



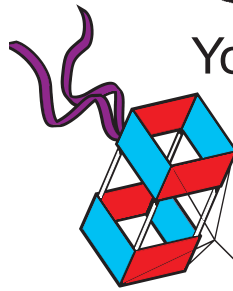
On South Korea's flag, white represents purity. Red and blue stand for cooperation and togetherness.

Rice is eaten at nearly every meal. Chopsticks must never touch the table once a meal begins. Instead, they are rested on the rice bowl.

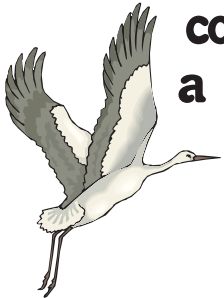
Korea means "high and clear" - a good description of the mountains and springs found here.
