The yellow lion that is on the country's flag is also on Sri Lanka's coat of arms.



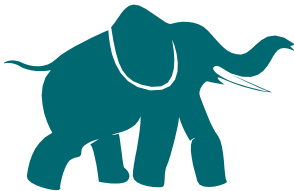
Graphite is a mineral found in Sri Lanka. It is used in making electric motors.
