Rice (fan) is an important staple. You might be greeted "Chi fan le mei you?" - which means "Have you eaten rice?"

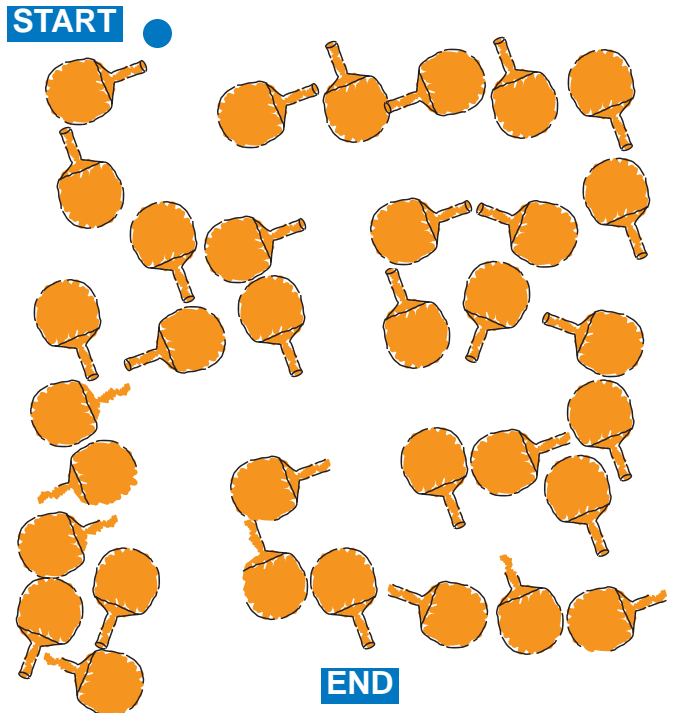


People in Taiwan enjoy the sports of basketball, baseball and table tennis - sometimes called ping pong.
