Tim will meet with his surgeon on Friday June 5th. Tim is scheduled for radioactive iodine therapy June 8-12. This will mean Tim is on a restricted iodine free diet. Tim and Lily will have to social distance for at least for days. Thank you for your concern, and pray all this will go smoothly.

In one of our appointments at the hospital, we were introduced to a Christian woman named Monica whose mother has Colon cancer. We have visited with them a few times. Her mother accepted the Lord, but she needs a lot of encouragement at this time. Right now she is in chemo therapy and radiation to shrink the tumor. However, they live quite far from us. So we have introduced them to friends of ours, Alan and Debbie. Their church is just nearby Monica's house. Pray for Monica and her mother to grow stronger in their faith and hope.

Yesterday we went to visit a man introduced to us by Mr. Gwo. Mr. Jen who has recovered from Tonsil cancer told us he feels useless. Tim shared his story about his lost of sight and how that changed his life. Although Mr. Jen is not a believer yet, but before we left we could sense a softening in his heart. Lily gave him a gospel tract that he promise to read. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move his heart. We hope for another opportunity to visit him.

Pray for Josephine's father Mr. Chen. He accepted the Lord in the hospital when we visited him. However, now he does not want to be baptized. He is ninety years old and his faith is very little. Please pray for Josephine and her sister Lynn who are taking care of two elderly parents. Also pray for Mr. Chen to really commit to the LORD.

On Saturday May 30th, the church did an outreach in a nearby community. Seven people pass out gospel tracts and talk to people. We separated into three groups. Many people politely accepted the tract. Pray for their hearts to be opened by the Holy Spirit. Afterwards, we went to visit an elderly woman that attends our church. Ms. Liu lives on the sixth floor with no elevator. She has several physical problems, such as dizziness, stomach pain and leg pain. She would like to work, but because of her physical problems she cannot. The purpose to visit her was to let the church pray and encourage her.

Thank you for praying for our English fellowship. Some stopped coming because of the COVID-19 virus. Praise the LORD, they are starting to come back. We always start with a short game and then a Bible study. We always enjoy eating together. Right now most of the people coming are believers, but we are praying for more seekers to come.

We are thankful for the ministry that Joycelyn has at the junior high school. The school is asking the church to consider a three day camp sometime in their summer vacation. Pray for us as we decide how to do this ministry opportunity. In the picture the students are attending an activity about not using drugs.
