### **Praises**

- **New Believers.** We are truly delighted to report the amazing results that the Lord brought about through the 10x10 church planting effort in Necocli, Northern Colombia over the last week and a half. To God's credit, we are reporting 70+ new believers with over forty children and almost 30 adults having made faith decisions!
- **New Groups.** We are also glad to share that 4 new discipleship groups have been formed in the homes of new believers. This is critical as 10x10 isn't an event, but rather the beginning phase of a church planting process. Six of the 10 participants (in the photo above) will be travelling multiple times a week to provide discipleship and leadership for the new believers in their discipleship groups.
- **New Leaders.** A big goal for 10x10 is to prepare disciple-making leaders through hands-on training. We are excited to say that this certainly was accomplished! Many of the 10 leaders are not only confident and competent to use the new tools they learned, but they will also be sharing them with their home congregations.

- **The Rosados arrived!** Rodrigo, Tanya and their 3 year-old daughter Ellia, arrived safe and sound on Wednesday night and are getting adapted well. We are happy to be able to house-share for the next few weeks as they wait for their host country (Argentina) to open its doors to incoming travelers.
- **Church is back in session!** For the first time since April 27th, our local Tocancipa church was able to meet in person this last Sunday. It was wonderful to gather with them again!
- Many of you have been praying for the newly-widowed **Mercedes**. We had a chance to be with her family on Sunday and learned that the Lord has provided her with a steady means of income - a huge answer to prayer! Her strength and courage is truly amazing, and despite her ongoing grieving, she is working from home providing over-the-phone follow-up and counselling for Covid survivors and their families.

### **Requests**

- Even as Covid recedes in the US and much of Europe, it is still raging here in Colombia (and much of Latin America). Here, we are at the highest peak of the pandemic, and registering roughly 2-4 x more new daily cases now than during any other point of the outbreak. Pray for vaccination rates to increase, and for the current crisis to abate soon.
- Pray for deep roots for the new believers in Necocli!
- Today, the first in-person pastoral formation course wraps up with over 45 students having taken the course in northern Colombia. Pray for the material (Spiritual Formation) to bear much fruit!
- Luis Porras, one of the pastors from northern Colombia (who along with the rest of the Uraba network are in the process of affiliating into the FMC) lost his fight to Covid over the past 24 hours. Please pray for Luis' wife Adalgisa, and for their church community which is reeling.
- Thad's sister, Vangie, suffered flooding in her home in Mississippi over the weekend. Pray for her as she searches for new lodging, files claims for her

totalled car, and begins piecing together what she needs for her household. Pray also that the Lord would be near to her during this extremely trying time.
