
- With such a great January and February!

One day at the gym, the owner Anna Carol who is a physiotherapist and a member of the Free Methodist Church here in Portugal, noticed Isabel's troubled spirit and invited her to go to

the youth service that night.

Isabel says: "When I entered the church, I felt like I was in another world. I was greeted me with hugs and kisses and made to feel so loved and respected. The Word preached that night seemed to have been given just for me. He was speaking about my life! How could it be? I began to cry as I felt the Holy Spirit transforming my life there in that service. With the grace of God I could forgive everyone and be completely free!"

Today Isabel is employed, her marriage restored and even had her dream of going to Israel become a reality last March when a group from our churches were able to go with us on this trip. She is involved in the life of the church, attends a cell group, and helps with social projects – always available to help with anything we need.
