Praise the Lord for our Mother's Day service. The blind women shared their testimonies and sang several songs. One of the songs that touched people's hearts was a song from John 9:1-3. There were three non-Christians who came. One of them was a single mother with three kids. Her name is Jennifer. We are trying to witness to her. On a couple of Sundays she brought her children with her on the motorcycle which we called the family car. Her children attend the Saturday morning English class which is led by Irene. Because of the pandemic, we don't know if we can continue this class or not. Local cases are between eighty or ninety thousand a day in Taiwan. Please pray for our leaders to make a wise decision on keeping the church open or going back to online service.

Thank you for praying for our Tuesday afternoon reading group led by pastor Jiang. We hope what we learn about relationship in the family can be practically used. We know this will take time but we hope to see families transform by God. One of the members is a non-Christian. She is a single woman named Kelly. We are glad that we can openly share in the group. We hope for a chance to talk to Kelly and if she wants to come to Sunday service, pastor Jiang promised to accompany her. The reading group has two more times to meet.

Thank you for praying for our Saturday morning Taiwanese group. Although most of them find reading to be difficult, Mr. Zen always brings his Bible. We started to meet in Mr. Pang's house. We noticed the posters on his wall that troubles his mind. So Mr. Gwo and Mr. Hwang took the posters down and replaced it with the picture of Jesus. We also meet in Mr. Hsu's house since his mother in law came back from the nursing home. Elijah uses pictures to tell the Bible story.

Thank you for praying for our English fellowship. Recently a young woman named Jessica has been coming. We met her on our Christmas Eve when we went out caroling last year. She was introduced to us by Mary in Jessica's family store. We are trying to encourage her to read PURPOSE DRIVEN LIFE in English, and when she is ready she will read to Tim on the phone. Lily gave her a Chinese Bible and she uses it to prepare for the English fellowship lessons. Pray for her heart to be touched by the Holy Spirit.

Thank you for praying for our church roof repair. The work was done just before the raining season came.

Continue to pray for the healing of Lily's right wrist. She has two more treatments to treat the ligaments. Praise the Lord she can now have Tim on the back of the scooter. Right now just to the church and home.
