This family was brought to our attention by Wendy's second grade teacher. We tried to help Mike in our house after school until his mother came to pick him up. Now the teacher wants Mike to come with Wendy together to the church's after school care ministry. Pray for Irene to help these special kids.

We are thankful for Irene who put together a thanksgiving wall in the church. This is in preparation for our December 25th end of the year thanksgiving service. Next Sunday Lily's sermon will be about practicing thanksgiving is part of the preparation for Dec. 25th. We want to prepare people's heart to support a Christian hospital. The hospital wants to buy a medical machine that can check for cancer. There will be an offering in the second service on the 25th. Pray for the Lord's will be done.
