Last February, 161 people were baptized in Cambodia; in the past five years, the Free Methodist Church in Thailand grew from 12 to 1,608 members and from 1 to 14 churches. In Latin America, 8,500 have accepted Christ, and more than 1,750 have been baptized in the last three years. And in the Middle East, house churches are being planted almost faster than we can count. Wow! Praise God!

Wilmore, Kentucky, captured our attention for several weeks. We were in awe. We long for the outpouring of the Spirit like that into our lives and churches.

I thought about these things as I walked through the empty cathedrals of Europe and bumped into young people partying in church squares at night. I had agonizing conversations with godly, called, gifted church leaders whose hearts are broken for the lost, the lonely and the oppressed.


Our response is to give attention to results. We are drawn to the wonder. We give to success. But don't all people matter? Even those in the graveyards of Christianity? Don't our struggling church plants in places like Hungary and Spain deserve our attention, support, encouragement and financial support? Both faithfulness and success matter. Faithfulness gives people like Larry and Katie Winckles the power to stay the course on the field for 23 years. How do we define success? What do we count? However, God is present in their lives and work, and we should be in awe of their perseverance and faithfulness just as much as we are amazed by the outpourings in Kentucky, Cambodia, Thailand, Colombia, the Middle East and elsewhere.

People were hungry and needed access to healthy, clean food. The needs of the Kyustendil, Bulgaria, community were communicated to us, missionaries Chance and Dee Dee Galloway, by a local Bulgarian, Stanimir Zahariev. Seeing the need and knowing the rich and plentiful soil in the region became an obvious bridge to providing for the needs.

The Pure Farm was birthed in 2018. By 2020, four greenhouses had been added, allowing increased yield. Then came the global pandemic. The COVID-19 lockdown made access to food even more scarce. The Pure Farm allowed us to feed 26 communities during that time.

We have watched God continue to grow the farm. With the help of FM churches, a tractor was donated in 2021. Tractor attachments were added in 2022 and 2023.

Our holistic approach to ministry equips individuals to experience God's provision and power in their lives. The Pure Farm project focuses on feeding the community with the fruits of our labor. Moreover, we empower individuals by teaching the skill of farming and hard, prosperous work to promote self-sufficiency. Our mission is to provide meals

as we fellowship with one another, growing and living in love. As we build strong relationships in the community, we help families living in extreme poverty find hope in Jesus. In 2020, the Feeding Program impacted over 450 families throughout Bulgaria.

The Pure Farm is an organic and environmentally conscious farm led by Stanimir Zahariev. We grow fresh, organic fruits and vegetables to supply those in need as we invest in the nationals and feed the hungry. As we meet the need, we present the gospel. We are the hands and feet of Jesus with the mission of serving others.

Our goals are to bring food and training consistently and to perpetually add more land projects in all the regions where we are engaged.

Many lives have been impacted by the Pure Farm project, thanks to Jesus' love and provision and the volunteers' hard work and dedication.

# GOSPEL IMPACT

In October 2020, I was bored on a Friday night, casually watching "Mediterranean Living" on HGTV. I jokingly texted my adult children, expressing the idea of moving to Spain. Little did I know that the following morning, I would receive confirmation from the Lord. He was calling me to leave behind my established coaching practice, family, church and community to embark on a new journey in a foreign land with few acquaintances, uncertain demand for my professional skills and no knowledge of the language.

My participation in the 2018 "We Love Spain Cycling Tour" gave me a glimpse into the Mosaico Cultural Center and the missionary work in the European region. It inspired me to begin the application process to become a VISA Voyager missionary with Free Methodist World Missions. After completing the process and obtaining a Spanish visa, I boarded a plane to Spain, accompanied by five large suitcases and my faithful dog, Penny Lane.

The first year was challenging, adapting to cultural differences, navigating language barriers and being separated from my family. Although moments of fear and uncertainty crept in, there was a deep sense of peace, knowing God had called me for a specific purpose and He would be by my side.

Through this journey, I have come to recognize how God also equips individuals with professional skills to contribute to missions. My role now involves providing leadership coaching and development to European missionaries and leadership teams in Europe. We begin by using the Gallup CliftonStrengths® assessment to understand each person's unique strengths, fostering collaboration and forming diverse teams. Additionally, the European teams have access to workshops on Emotional Intelligence, Myers-Briggs, Conflict Resolution, Difficult Conversations and Wellness. It has been an incredible privilege to serve individuals in Spain, Bulgaria, Greece, Belgium and the Canary Islands over the past 17 months.

Before this assignment, I had yet to fully grasp how professional skills could enhance missionaries' effectiveness in their communities.

My prayer and intention are to use my skill set and calling to support and serve the European team, making a lasting impact on others for the gospel's sake.

# **06** ➤ Wednesday | Thailand

In 2018, missionaries Jason and Wendi began the process of adopting a little girl from an Asian creative access country. This process was delayed due to pandemic restrictions. They may be able to complete the adoption in September. Pray for the Lord's timing and provision. **Birthday: Jason** 

# **07 ≻ Thursday** | Togo

Pray for a rural FM church in the Fazao area in northern Togo. This church has a ministry to about 160 children. Ask God to give wisdom and provide resources.
