





For a long time, I have had terrible headaches. They would never leave me. They were severe, and I could not get relief. But Jesus saved me from this and so much else!

Before I knew Jesus, my life seemed hopeless. Even in my youth, I had no father, no chance to study, and our family was very poor. I dreamed of a marriage that would rescue me from hopelessness, but my life did not improve even after marriage. It became worse. To my heartbreak, my husband had an affair, and we were in near-constant conflict. Eventually, we divorced, leaving me as a single mother with four children.

In addition to trying to care for our family as a single parent, I was responsible for the care of my elderly mother. Again, life was hard and hopeless, and my headaches became even worse. I tried many different medications, visited many doctors, and tried traditional medicine. I worshiped ancestors and earth spirits. But all left me empty and without hope. I felt helpless.

One day my brother, who had become a Christian, helped me to come to a church. There I met a pastor who prayed for me. Other brothers and sisters from the fellowship prayed for me regularly, and I began to feel better. I heard the gospel and trusted Jesus as my Lord and Savior.

Today I am filled with hope in Jesus! I have brothers and sisters in Christ as my extended family, and I no longer feel alone. I was baptized in July of 2022, and I happily participate in my local church in the province and city when I visit.

From despair to hope! This is how Sister Gne describes her transformation.

Participating Together in the Work of the Spirit

Kyaw Aung is an example of one who realized his spiritual needs when his physical needs were met. This often happens through the generosity and kindness expressed

through the Bishops' Crisis Response Fund (BCRF). FMWM-Asia values partnerships like this, built within the generosity of the FMC-USA.

Superintendent Pa Kep shares Kyaw Aung's story. Kyaw Aung was born into a Buddhist family. Like most in Creative Access-MR, Kyaw Aung held a strong belief in Buddhism. By trade, he has been a mason, crafting images of the Buddha for worship and assisting in constructing several pagodas. Idols are kept in most Buddhist households. Daily offerings of fruit are made in these home shrines. According to Pa Kep, Kyaw Aung also sold idols for peoples' homes.

Kyaw Aung was performing his worship one morning when he began thinking about the nature of the gods he had

made with his hands. Are these real? Do they have any ability to hear my prayers? Can they save lives? A sinking feeling crept in and brought trouble and unrest to his mind.

It was not long before Kyaw Aung lost his joy in worshiping the idols in his home. He had a growing awareness of the lack of peace in his life. Kyaw Aung wondered: *Might there* be a God somewhere who could hear, a God who is able to save? In December 2021, he attended a gathering in his community. The gathering was associated with

> Christmas. Invited by a neighbor, he went to receive a gift of rice, but in the end, Kyaw Aung received so much more.

During the gathering, Kyaw Aung heard the good news about Jesus and the love of the Father. Through the true meaning of Christmas – the gift of God's Son, Jesus, he found the God for whom he had longed! Eager to learn more about Jesus, he asked for more information, received one handout and met a Free Methodist pastor.

It was not long before the Holy Spirit began moving in Kyaw Aung's heart. He was drawn deeply to the teachings of Jesus found in the Bible. Pastor Ni, our FM pastor, helped Kyaw Aung surrender to Jesus in October

2022, and soon after, he was baptized.

If you have given to the BCRF, the LoveAsia fund or the Creative Access-MR Church Planting and Development (CPD) fund, you have participated in the Holy Spirit's work in Kyaw Aung's life. As a denominational family, we are an amazing example of how we can be better together.

God is at work in Creative Access-PN, and He is working through the Free Methodist churches there. Hear this story from one of our key leaders, Pastor M.

Praise the Lord for His grace! The Free Methodist Church (FMC) in Creative Access-PN is deeply involved in spreading the good news to slave families, helping them break free from slavery to live a life of dignity. We thank God for His powerful, strong, and compassionate hand stretching out to help us release a slave family by paying off their loans to the brick kiln owner, equivalent to 945 U.S. dollars. This family was facing severe persecution and trouble. I am deeply grateful to my friend, who immediately sold a piece of land and provided the money to release this family in an emergency.

The father in this family is RM, and his wife is H. They have six children, and one of their daughters was a victim of sexual assault by the brick kiln owner. He then married her to a Muslim man without her parents' permission. He also started harassing her mother and attempted to assault her. When the parents raised their voices against the brick kiln owner, he threatened to kill RM and demanded his money back. RM managed to escape and hide, saving his life.

This family had been living in slavery from birth, but now they are free.

We paid the money to the owner and freed this Christian family from slavery. After the husband returned home and was reunited with his family, we arranged a rental house for their accommodation and purchased a rickshaw loader. The rickshaw loader gave RM a business, enabling him to earn money to support the family's needs and expenses. Now they are incredibly happy, free to worship our Lord and live their Christian life in freedom.

Creative Access-PN is a difficult place to share the gospel, and few want to serve there. But our Free Methodist family is touching lives with the gospel of Christ. As followers of Jesus, they believe all are created in the image of God and worthy of the love, dignity and hope offered to them in Christ. Please pray for the transformative work of the FMC in this country.

Pray for the strength and wisdom of the church in the city of Santa Cruz as it ministers to and seeks transformation in the community.

04 > Wednesday | Creative Access-P / Latin America

Creative Access-P: Pray God's Spirit will move in amazing and miraculous ways to transform this nation.

Birthday: Tanya (Affiliate Missionary)
