Quasad is a 26-year-old man whose life has been transformed by the grace of God.

When Quasad was a young boy, he ran away from home with dreams of becoming rich. He joined a gang involved in drug trafficking and began selling drugs to others, eventually using them himself. His life quickly spiraled into addiction, crime and hopelessness as he sought money and escape in all the wrong places.

On June 9, 2024, Quasad's life took a dramatic turn. That afternoon, he arrived at a hotel to deliver drugs to a buyer. Michael Bridge, a youth leader from the Free Methodist Church, happened to be there and observed Quasad as he conducted his business. As Quasad prepared to leave, Michael approached him and invited him to sit and join him for a cup of tea.

Assuming Michael was a potential buyer, Quasad agreed, expecting to make a sale. But instead of a customer, he found someone who cared deeply about his soul. Michael began sharing stories of redemption, transformation and freedom from sin through Jesus Christ. He spoke about young people whose lives had been changed by the power of God and explained the gospel, emphasizing God's love and His plan for Quasad's life.

As Michael shared these truths, the Holy Spirit moved in Quasad's heart. He felt convicted of his sins and overwhelmed by the possibility of a new beginning. Right there, on the spot, Quasad repented, gave his life to God and accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior.

Quasad's transformation was immediate and profound. He walked away from his old life of addiction and crime and stepped into a new life in Christ. Today, he is an active member of the Free Methodist Church and is growing in his faith. He has found purpose, peace, and hope he never thought possible.

Quasad's story is a testament to the goodness and mercy of God. It reminds us no one is beyond redemption, and God desires to save and transform every sinner. We pray Quasad's journey will inspire others – especially those battling addiction – to find freedom and hope in Christ. May God continue to work in Quasad's life, shaping him into a vessel of His grace and using him to lead others – especially those trapped in addiction – to the saving knowledge of Jesus.

My name is Htwe Min Htet. I was born into a devout Buddhist family in Creative Access-MR. My parents are deeply committed to Buddhism and serve on the committee of pagoda trustees. As a child, I often accompanied them to the pagoda, worshiping gods, and striving to develop inner peace and good behavior.

After finishing my training and certification, I became a public transportation driver. My job took me across the country, where I met people from diverse cultures and religions, including Christians, Muslims and Hindus.

Like many, I worked hard to earn money, hoping it would bring satisfaction. But no matter how much I earned, I felt an emptiness within – a deep thirst in my spirit and a persistent lack of peace. I continued visiting the pagoda and worshiping gods, but nothing filled the void.

In 2019, I drove a group of Christians from Mandalay to Kalamyo. During the trip, I overheard them discussing peace and the meaning of life. Their words intrigued me, and I began asking them questions. We talked throughout the day, and I felt a growing desire to know more about their God. A desire to know more about the Christian's God stayed with me for years. In 2023, through a friend in the capital city, I had the opportunity to meet a pastor. He explained to me about the Creator, His creation, the reality of death and the promise of eternal life.

The Holy Spirit began to move in my heart as I learned about Jesus' love and salvation. I finally experienced the peace I had been searching for. That peace led me to make the most important decision of my life: I received Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.

I knew my parents would be upset with my decision, but I could not replace the peace I had found in Christ with anything else. The very next day, I attended a baptism class and was baptized.

Though I am still a new believer, I am confident in my faith. I continue to pray my parents will one day experience the same peace and transformation I have found.

From Respected Monk to a Child of the TRUE

For much of his life, Kong Trav was a devout Buddhist. He even served as a monk for many years, completely dedicated to his faith and practices. His commitment to Buddhism earned him respect in his community, and he believed he was pursuing a path to peace and enlightenment.

Two years after stepping away from his role as a monk, Trav encountered the gospel through Pastor Joseph and Pastor Koy. These two Cambodian pastors shared the message of Jesus Christ with him, explaining the truth of the Creator, the way to eternal life, and the futility of relying on human efforts for salvation. Intrigued and seeking deeper understanding, Trav began attending church-planting efforts in Preaek Khlork.

Through these experiences, Trav, now an 83-year-old man, came to believe in Jesus as the one true and living God – the only way to eternal life. He realized that despite his years of devotion and the merit he had earned through Buddhist practices, those efforts could not save him or secure a place in heaven. He was baptized in June 2024.

When Trav accepted Jesus, he experienced a peace and joy he had never known before. He found freedom in Christ and confidence in his salvation. Trav has no regrets about leaving his former beliefs behind, as he knows the truth and power of the gospel have transformed his life forever.

Today, Trav is a vibrant testimony of God's grace and redemption. At 83, he stands firm in his faith, proclaiming Jesus as the only true God and rejoicing in the peace and joy only Christ can bring.
