

Mobilizing and Conting

Latin American CCP Team Member, and Beth Gómez

There are three general conferences in Latin America: Haiti, Brazil and the Dominican Republic. Each has its own vision, mission and government, and consequently only has a fraternal relationship with the Latin American Area. The relationship with Brazil first began to change when Venezuelans immigrated to Brazil and began opening houses of peace, a strategy of the Community Church Planting (CCP) movement. Because of this reality, Latin American multiplication team members began advising and supporting the work in Brazil. Now, the movement is growing within another general conference.

In 2013, members of the Free Methodist General Conference in the Dominican Republic (DR) received a promise from God. He promised to expand their ministry



and unite their country with what He was doing in the rest of the Latin American Area. The young people in the Dominican Republic began praying in earnest and waiting for God's timing.

In 2019, on a family vacation to Colombia, Pastor Audy Martinez met Pastor John Jairo Leal, who shared with him about the CCP movement. Audy was impressed by how local churches employed this simple but biblical strategy and saw real growth. He shared the vision with his church, which began to pray for the movement.

Then, in March 2024, Audy took a small delegation of youth and another pastor to the first Latin American Youth Summit. At the summit, he met Dr. Ricardo Gómez, who explained the strategy and connected him

with Pastor Alí León, a CCP mentor. Alí's first step was to offer a virtual Disciples Multiplying Disciples (DMD) training to 30 members of two Dominican churches. Then, in November, Alí went to the Dominican Republic, where he provided additional training to the group of 30 and shared the vision with another group of pastors and leaders.

Today, Pastor Audy reports there are already 14 houses of peace meeting in the DR, but they are not satisfied. They believe God's promise was for something greater and know He is always faithful to His Word. So, they continue to pray and share the vision, training laypeople to share the story of what God has done in their lives so that others might believe. In the process, God is uniting the vision of the Latin American Area and the Dominican Republic.

Living in Transformational Community

As we sat together in the conference room for the Strategic Planning Retreat, we realized in reverent gratitude that almost everything God was doing in our midst was new. Flipchart sheets compiled during the week lined the walls, each one capturing a small part of the big

story newly playing out in our midst. The 1,116 houses of peace, the 1,200-plus leaders in ministerial formation, and the 90 community transformation initiatives are all new.

Even the leaders are new. Not one person on the Latin American leadership team has been in their role for more than six years! Sarah (Latin American ICCM coordinator), Pedro (newest member of the coaching team) and Sofia (leader of the financial team) have only been serving for a year. Jazmin just stepped in as the Set Free Movement coordinator in Latin America eight months ago. Just a few years ago, the effective

mentor for leaders in Uruguay and Argentina was an unbelieving physical education teacher. The director of communications started life in a broken home but was practically adopted by missionaries.

Throughout the week, we spent time praying, listening and sharing the stories of how God is powerfully moving

in the 19 countries where the team works – from Mexico to Argentina. A single mother came to Christ due to her child's participation in the *Raices* discipleship program. A Chilean woman was saved, discipled and encouraged to lead her own house of peace and is completing her 19th

ministry formation course in route to potential pastoral ordination. A Free Methodist church in Bolivia helped foil a human-trafficking ring.

The retreat helped us move from "team" to "community." Specifically, our goal was to become a "discerning community," a group of leaders who develop and deepen personal and corporate spiritual practices to help us perceive where the Lord is at work and to partner with Him more effectively in that space.

Our shared vision is to participate with God in the restoration of Latin

America. This vision is our heartbeat, our driving passion. But it is more; it is also our shared story visible in the lives of our leaders, plastered on flipchart papers, and shared in written and spoken testimonies from the field. God is bringing about His restoration in the region; these fresh new stories are a testament to the movement of God.

Freedom in Solwia

Two years ago, the transformational church pillar of the Latin American Area began sponsoring "Freedom Week" to create awareness of modern-day slavery and to begin initiatives to combat trafficking. Area-wide programming in the first year inspired more churches to join in "Freedom Week" activities in the second year and start their own programs.

The Free Methodist (FM) Church in Santa Cruz, Bolivia, invited local police to give a workshop about the *Alerta Juliana* (similar to the Amber Alert used in the USA). Police explained how this alert system is becoming increasingly necessary in Bolivia because, within five years, the confirmed cases of human trafficking of Bolivian citizens have nearly doubled, and over 54% of the rescued victims have been minors. The police also taught participants how to initiate and use the alert system.

Four months later, Juan*, the 14-year-old grandson of one of the Santa Cruz church members, was

kidnapped on his way home from school. The news was devastating, but the family knew what to do because of the *Alerta Juliana* workshop. An immediate alert was issued, spreading the information to the community and authorities. Thanks to their quick action and the use of this tool, within 24 hours Juan was found and rescued. This incident and Juan's recovery helped officials uncover a human-trafficking ring and rescue several girls who, like Juan,were on the verge of being illegally smuggled into Chile.

We thank the Lord for the many ways the Free Methodist Church in Latin America participates with God in the restoration of the region and actively seeks love-driven justice through initiatives that bring about community transformation for the glory of God.
