Tanya and Rodrigo are based in Buenos Aires, Argentina and lead in three main areas:

An **international** church

We are an international church in the midst of a very cosmopolitan city. This church was started by and for Japanese speakers living in the city, but when we arrived in November 2021 there were only 8 people still gathering regularly. Three and half years later, there are 5 community churches with an average of 40 people meeting weekly from 9 different countries!



Gathered and Scattered

Our weekly services follow a rhythm of being gathered and scattered. We **GATHER** once a month in all-community gathering bringing the 5 communities together for worship, the word and food. Throughout the month we **SCATTER** in our missional communities in different languages, cultures, and locations to best share the good news of Jesus where people live.



Living the Hope of **Jesus**

We disciple every member to live the hope of Jesus wherever they are. But we focus on our 10 lay leaders who help lead those communities training them to go deep in relationship with Jesus and further on mission with Jesus, equipping them to disciple others.



Argentina Mission District



AT A GLANCE

- Free Methodist work in 4 provinces and the capital city of Buenos Aires
- 4 established churches

The mission district continues to grow. This past April they celebrated the 3rd annual session since the restart, but that annual session was wrapped into family camp, where 85 people including 20 children and teens considered the call God might have to participate in the restoration of Argentina. A new elder, Jonathan Mogollon, was ordained for the first time in 8 years and has begun a new work in Mendoza.
