Nundu News Update

This report is a follow-up to our report of July 27: A tree has fallen on the Matthewson House, causing considerable damage. Thankfully, no one was injured, even though visitors, Dr. McGee and Dr. ByaMungu, were present and trapped inside for a short time.

Paul Ikocha, builder and engineer, has assessed the damage and reports that roof repairs and restoration of the guest house can be done at a total cost of less than \$1000. Materials needed include metal roofing, ridge caps, nails, lumber to rebuild the trusses, and paint for interior repairs. Labor is estimated to come to \$145. Imagine if your home were damaged to this extent. What would be the cost of repairing the damage? (Please note the attached document for details.)
