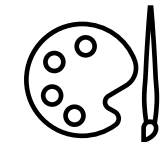

Interesting Facts:

- This country has **five of the 14 tallest mountains in the whole world.**
- **Most people live in the countryside,** not in big cities.
- The **national sport** is field hockey.
- People **drive on the left side of the road.**
- Their food has been influenced by **India, Britain, the Middle East, and other Asian countries,** so it often **smells really good and tastes spicy.**
- Families usually **eat together from one big plate,** taking the food that's closest to them.
- The **national drink** is sugarcane juice.
- There are **835 people groups** in this country, and **828 of those groups have not heard the message of the gospel.**
- Animals you might see include **brown bears, black Himalayan bears, wild sheep, snow leopards, crocodiles, pythons, wild boars, and jackals.**
- Road signs are written in **English and Urdu,** and people drive on the **left side.**

Up Close – Creative Access-PN

National Geographic Kids says that **glaciers** are **huge pieces of ice** that move very, very slowly, almost like a slow river. Glaciers form when **snow gets packed down for hundreds of years** and turns into ice.

This country has **over 7,000 glaciers,** which is more than any other country except those near the North and South Poles. Most glaciers are found in the **northern part.** They are beautiful to look at, but they can be **dangerous to climb** because of all the snow and ice.

If you visit the glaciers, you might see special animals like the **ibex**, the **markhor**, the **Himalayan brown bear**, or the **snow leopard**.

A very important river, the **I---s River**, exists mostly because of these glaciers. The river helps farmers grow food, and the glaciers help keep the country from getting too hot.

Things to Do if You Visit

- Look at the **famous rickshaws** covered in bright decorations that even **glow at night**.
- Visit and explore the **big cities**.
- Take a **hike in the mountains**.
- **Drink some warm tea** – a very popular drink there!

ADVENTURE STORY

From a Wrong Path to a New Life

Quasad is a young man whose life changed in an amazing and surprising way.

When Quasad was a boy, he ran away from home because he dreamed of becoming rich and living a fun, exciting life. But after leaving home, he made some very bad choices. He joined a group of people who were doing dangerous and illegal things, like selling drugs. At first, he only sold drugs, but soon he started using them too. This made him feel trapped, sad and hopeless, and his life felt like it was getting darker every day.

Then, on June 9, 2024, something incredible happened. Quasad went to a hotel to deliver drugs to someone. At the same time, a church youth leader named Michael was there and noticed what was happening. When Quasad finished and got ready to leave, Michael gently stopped him and invited him to sit down and have a cup of tea.

Quasad thought Michael wanted to buy drugs – but he didn't! Instead, Michael wanted to show kindness. He began telling Quasad stories about

young people whose lives had been completely changed by Jesus. He explained how God loved Quasad, cared about him deeply, and had a much better plan for his life than the one he was living.

As Michael talked, something stirred inside Quasad. He felt sorry for the wrong things he had done, and he realized he wanted a fresh start. Right there at the hotel, Quasad prayed, asked Jesus to forgive him, and chose to follow Him.

From that moment on, Quasad's life changed in a huge way. He stopped using drugs, left the group he was part of, and began going to church. Now he is learning more and more about God and discovering hope, peace and joy he never thought he could have.

Quasad's story shows that no one is too lost for God to help. He can give anyone a new beginning. We hope Quasad's journey encourages others – especially those who feel stuck or hopeless – to see that Jesus can bring freedom, healing and a brand-new life.



EXPLORE MORE

Discussion

How did Michael know that Quasad probably was not a follower of Jesus? (He noticed him selling drugs, and he knew that wasn't something someone who follows Jesus would do.)

What did Michael do that made all the difference in Quasad's life?

(Michael saw Quasad, he took time to talk to him, he showed him kindness, he told him stories about people whose lives had been changed by Jesus, and he told Quasad how much Jesus loved him.)

Connecting to Scripture

Here are some verses from our theme scripture:

Sing to the LORD, all the earth; proclaim his salvation day after day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples

– Psalms 96:1-3

These verses remind us of the mission God gives to everyone who believes in Him. We are to share the good news of Jesus with all people, everywhere — people far away and people nearby, people like us, and people who are different than we are.

Michael knows how much Jesus loves him, and he loves Jesus. He understands that his mission is to help other people know how much Jesus loves them. But Michael had to first notice Quasad and see his need.

How do we begin **sharing** the good news of Jesus?

- By telling people what we know to be true about Jesus from what we have learned in God's Word

– the Bible. We can share about Jesus' death and resurrection, as well as His love and forgiveness for each of us.

“Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth” (2 Timothy 2:15).

- We can also share how Jesus has changed our lives or how He helps us and cares for us.

(To the Teacher – share your own testimony.)

- We can give an example of Jesus by the way we live and how we treat others.

“By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another” (John 13:35).

So, keep your eyes open.

Notice people. See their needs.

Ask God to help you share His love with them.



Class Activity

Take students on a prayer walk in the neighborhood around the church or in a nearby park, stopping to pray for the people who live there and for anyone you see who might need to know that **Jesus loves them**.



PEOPLE ON ADVENTURE

We can't show pictures of the people on this adventure. Why? Because we want to keep them safe from anyone who might try to hurt them or make life hard for them. But you can still help – by praying for them! Pray for Pastor “M”; his wife, Amber; and their son, Michael.

“Dear God, thank You for Pastor ‘M,’ Amber and Michael. Please keep them safe and help their churches grow. Give them courage to keep telling other people about the love of Jesus. Amen.”



ADVENTURE IN PRAYER



PLAY-DOH PRAYERS

Give each child a piece of Play-Doh.

Shape the Play-Doh into a ball.

Pray for the World. Pray for the places where life is very hard, where there is war, disease, and a lack of food and water. Pray for places where people haven't yet heard the good news about Jesus.

Shape the Play-Doh into a cross.

Pray for the church in Creative Access-PN. Ask God to help Christians who are treated badly because they love Jesus. Pray that the church will shine His light in dark places.

Shape the Play-Doh into a heart.

Pray for people. Pray for the needy in Creative Access-PN. Pray for the leaders of the church. Pray the people who don't know Who Jesus is will come to know Him.

Shape the Play-Doh into the first letter of your name.

Pray for yourself. Ask God to help you see the people who need to know Jesus loves them. Pray you won't be afraid to share the good news of Jesus.

Give a closing prayer and then pass out Ziploc sandwich bags and let the children take home their lump of Play-Doh.

GAME

Rice Relay

What you need: 2 bags of rice



How to play: Divide the players into two teams, with an equal number of players on each team. Each team should stand in a straight line. Give a bag of rice to the first player on each team. At the starting signal, the team passes the bag from one player to the next between the players' legs. When the bag reaches the last person, it is passed back to the first player from one person to the next over the tops of their heads. The winner is the team whose first player gets the bag back first.



Option:

Pass the bag through the first person's legs and over the second person's head, alternating until the bag has been passed down the line and back to the first player again.



CRAFT

Woven Rug Art

Creative Access-PN Is Well Known for Woven Rugs

Supplies:

1 large piece of construction paper
several other brightly colored pieces of construction paper
brightly colored yarn cut into small 5" to 6" pieces
hole punch
scissors with decorative edges
glue

Directions:

Tear or cut strips of construction paper the width of the large piece of construction paper. Tear or cut enough strips of paper to cover the length of the large paper. Carefully begin gluing the cut or torn paper to the large paper. Choose a desired pattern. After you complete the process of gluing the paper strips, use a paper punch to punch several holes across both ends of the paper (the short edges). Holes should be about 1" apart. Thread two to three pieces of yarn through each hole and tie carefully so as not to rip the paper.

When completed, it can be used by students as a placemat or wall decoration.



FOOD



Fresh Fruit Bowl (Creative Access-PN)

Ingredients:

bananas	apples
oranges or clementines	pears
peaches	grapes
strawberries	watermelon
sugar to taste	dash of salt
1/4 to 1/2 teaspoon of black pepper	
1 teaspoon of ground cumin	
several drops of lemon, lime or orange juice	

Directions:

Cut up enough fruit to serve your students. Add as much sugar as you think is needed. Add fruit juice, salt, cumin and black pepper. Stir gently, making sure the fruit is well mixed. Feel free to substitute whatever fruits may be in season.

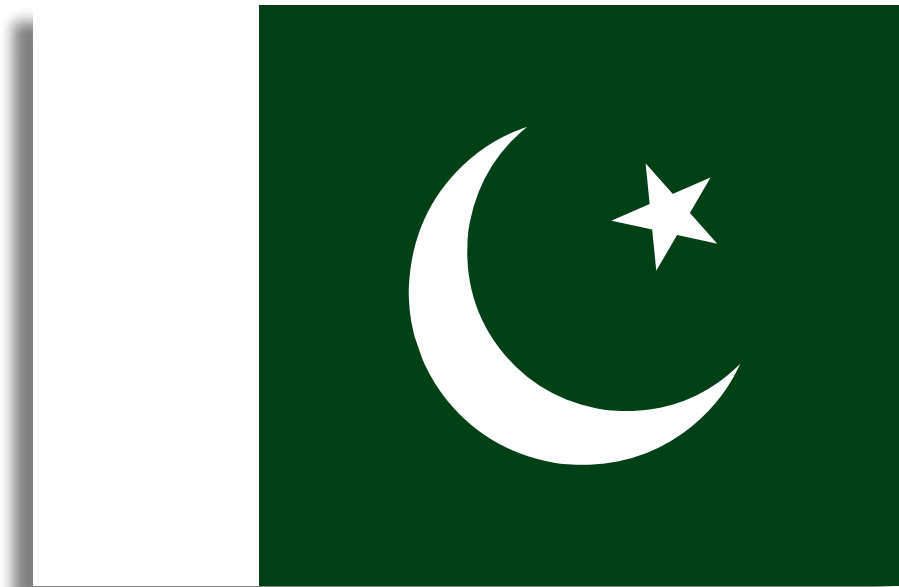

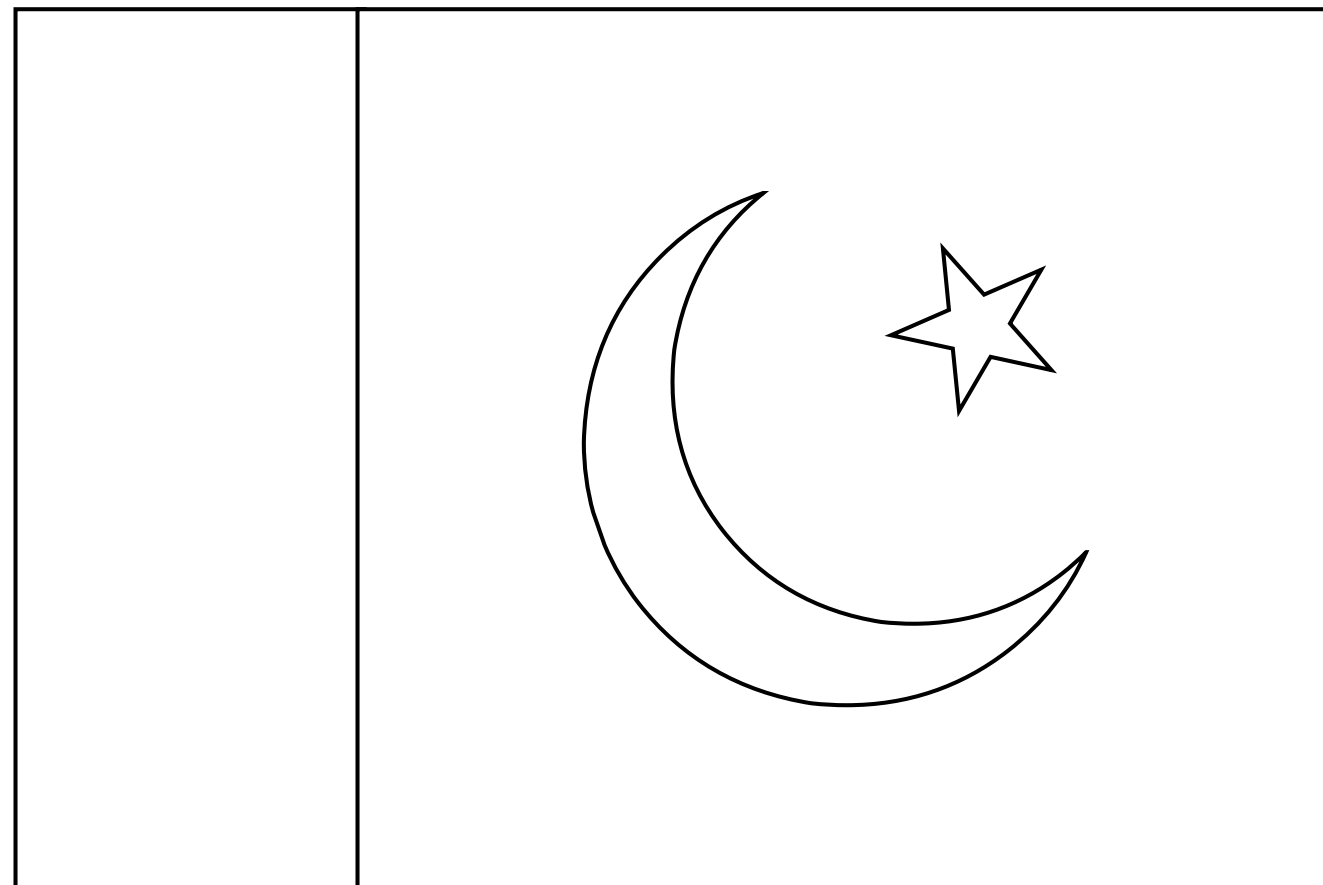
